Maden Technologies is pleased to announce that on May 23, 2007, the Navy awarded it a prime contract on its SeaPort Enhanced (SeaPort-e) multiple award contract. SeaPort-e's list of potential suppliers gives the Department of Defense (DoD) an alternative to doing business through the General Services Administration's supply schedules.

"We are excited to become part of the SeaPort-e contract. This award gives us tremendous opportunity to expand our fast-growing business in other DoD areas," said Omar Maden, CEO of Maden Technologies.

Maden Technologies is now pre-qualified to compete for bids for engineering, technical, and programmatic support from naval agencies, including Naval Sea Systems Command, Naval Air Systems Command, Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, Naval Supply Systems Command, Military Sealift Command, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Strategic Systems Programs, and the Marine Corps. The contracts have a two-year base period with up to eight option years. The Navy estimates that up to \$5.3 billion a year in orders could be issued under SeaPort-e.
